Which of the following is a recognized endoscopic classification system for the grading of Barrett's esophagus?

Answer: B

The Montreal classification is used in Crohn's disease to help stratify patients based on age, disease location, and behavior. Both the Los Angeles and Savary-Miller classifications are used in the grading of esophagitis. The Marsh classification is used to define the histopathologic disease severity in patients with Celiac disease. The Prague classification is used to grade Barrett's esophagus. The Prague classification looks at circumferential and maximal extent of involvement in a Barrett's segment.
