ANSWER: Sweet's Syndrome

Sweet's Syndrome is a rare association with IBD and can present with raised tender nodules on the face, arms trunk, Can have fever and constitutional symptoms. Biopsy shows an intense neutrophilic infiltrate but no vasculitis.
